A free migration lesson

The RSPB has also created a free migration lesson for Key Stage Two Geography.

By tracking the migration journeys of various birds, children can explore the reasons why birds might migrate which encourages conversation and comparison between differing climates etc. The lesson explores the countries, continents and oceans that are crossed the hazards they face which drives discussion around human and physical geography. There is also the opportunity to estimate the distances travelled.
