

## Application Guidelines For a Grant from the City Church Fund

The City Church Fund provides funding for works to specific churches in a defined geographical area (which includes some parishes in the Diocese of St Albans) for works which meet the following conditions:

- (i) for the maintenance of the fabric of churches;
- (ii) for the better endowment of existing benefices;
- (iii) for giving theological instruction to persons preparing for holy orders;
- (iv) generally for extending the benefit of clerical or spiritual ministrations in accordance with the doctrines or by the ministers of the Church of England;

It is accepted that the augmentation of stipends is an acceptable variant of the endowment of benefices.

You need to complete two forms to make an application: The online Grant Application Details form, available from the grants page of our website and the specific CCF Grant Application Form which should be downloaded as a word document, completed and saved as a pdf with the name 'CCF Grant Application XXX' (where XXX is the name of the parish).
