Week 6 – Journeying with God

Idea One: Road signs

Follow the normal routines for tutor-group worship.

Give students time to look at the road signs below (appendix). Which do they recognise? Which are they unsure about?

Explain that many people see life as a 'journey'. Many people take journeys on the road, where they use signs to help or guide them. If we thought about life as a journey, what might be key steps or moments? Starting a new school? Choice of career? Making new friends?

Which road signs do we think might be useful at different stages of this journey? (e.g. traffic lights might be useful before deciding on a career – a need to stop (red), think (amber) before deciding and moving on (green)).

I wonder which road signs might be helpful in helping Christians think about their journey with God? Invite students to discuss in pairs/threes and explain their choice/s (NB: the pupil-based video for this week gives examples of pupils justifying their road sign).

I wonder which road signs speak to you about your own spiritual journey right now?

Invite an opportunity for students to offer their reflections to God.

Idea Two: Take what you need

Follow the normal routines for tutor-group worship.

Thinking back - what have been the five most significant moments in their journey through life so far? Which of these would you consider to be 'spiritual'?

Thinking forward – what do you need to take for your journey ahead? Consider the options and take what you feel you need (blank tabs are there in case students feel they need something different, or to write one which has been taken by another).

Invite an opportunity for students to offer their reflections to God.
