

Quick Wins to save water in school

- Do a whole school check of taps and toilets to identify leaks and drips – carry out simple repairs
- Fit taps with low-flow devices to reduce the flow by up to 50%
- Place signage by all sinks reminding all to turn off taps
- Install water butts to collect rain water for use in school gardens and allotments – for more ways to sustainably return rain water into the water cycle [click here](#)
- Monitor your water usage across the year, large amounts of water being used during the holidays could be a sign of a leak
- Fit toilets with dual flush, with minimum volume being the default flush
- Wash paint brushes in pots of water rather than under a running tap
